Notes: Ariel Nuta Weinberg (1810-1902) and his wife Natalie (ca 1815-1911) had ten childre and their descendants flourished in Rumania, Austria, and Germany.

Their son, Robert, born 1900, was a lawyer & landowner, and lived in Bucarest until 1941. He married Mina Josipovici, born 1912. He built up a Jewish Sports Association in Rumania. Later, he emigrated to Israel and in 1947 was sent to Paris as Israeli envoy. Robert's sister, Paula Kerschen, born 1922, moved to Canada with her daughter Vera, and has left some notes on the Weinberg family.

¹ Marcus Weinberg (born 1868) married Rosa Filip Leibovici (1880-1944), sister of Simon Filip, Minister of Communications under King Carol of Rumania.

Georges Weinberg, a chemical engineer and gifted musician, became Rumanian Minister for the Petroleum Industry, and later emigrated to Israel.
