<b>1</b> Small grey hard-cover book.	1912	Baby's Record Book ('Mother's Notes about her Baby'). Partly completed for John Edward Christopher Hill.
<b>2</b> Green card cover notebook.	? 1930 ? Poems seem to be dated 1927 – 1930.	Poetry. Some neat in ink, others in pencil with changes, suggesting at least some of the poems are Hill's own. Notes on and poems by Watts, Rochester, Smollet, Butler, Roy Campbell and Clare.
<b>3</b> Fawn cloth cover notebook.	????? 1930s	Appears to be a diary of incidents, relationships etc, some relate to UK some to time spent in ? Europe, learning Russian ? in the 1930s. Some passages could be Hill writing a novel ? in the third person.
<b>4</b> Small brown cloth photo album.	1936	Inscription inside front cover in German, Freiburg i. Br[eisgau] 36. Photos of group of young and sometimes older people. Male & female, look mixture of English & German. In town & countryside, all outdoors. Hill in most pictures.
<b>5</b> Small dark brown imitation leather book.	1938	Book of signed (men & women) messages mostly in Spanish, many saying Viva la Republica. Three poems, one in English, to Hill. Presume by way of sad farewell as he was about to leave Cardiff and return to Balliol in summer 1938.
<b>6</b> Brown cloth cover notebook.	????? 1940s	Addresses. Some drawings and notes on front flyleaf. Addresses in UK, Europe, America, Middle East etc Including: R H Tawney; Philip Toynbee; CV Wedgwood; Balogh etc.
<b>7</b> Torn off Grey front cover of index book.	1970s ???	Address book. Only front end papers and first sheet of 'A' remain. Addresses in UK, Delhi & Bangkok.
<b>8</b> Torn buff envelope folder	1983-1992. Also items from 1960s and 1970s.	Lists of Christmas cards received, sent, presents to get/received. Some cards etc.
<b>9</b> Padded envelope.	Late 1980s	Hill Royalties and investments.
<b>10</b> Blue folder	1970-84	Hill royalties for tapes on 17 <sup>th</sup> century Science – Sussex Tapes.
<b>11</b> Loose papers	No date	Finances.
<b>12</b> Blue folder	1989-92	Mostly Hills' community charge papers, Cherwell District Council. They declined to pay Poll Tax.
<b>13</b> Buff folder	1989-90	Expenses for visit by C & B Hill to University of California, Los Angeles – UCLA.
<b>14</b> Buff folder	1984-1992	Hill contacts and publishing in Brazil.
<b>15</b> Cream folder	1962-96	Hill visit to and contacts in Japan.
<b>16</b> Grey paper cover notebook with black spine.	? 1962	Visit to Japan.
<b>17</b> Buff folder	1983-84	Hill contacts with China.
<b>18</b> Red plastic folder	1987 1996-97	Past & Present, administrative papers.
<b>19</b> Pink folder	1963-69	Oxford Climate Change Group, call for members & contributions.
<b>20</b> Buff folder	1988	D Selbourne. Ruskin College: free speech. Papers relating to Hill acting as Expert Witness in Ruskin College, Oxford case.

<b>26</b> Grey card cover notebook.	Oct 1931- April 1936. Begins as Hill came up to Balliol.	Reading list. Mostly English but also French, German, Russian books.
<b>27</b> Grey card cover notebook.	????? used over a period in late 1920s, early 1930s ?	Poetry, some possibly his own. 2 <sup>nd</sup> sheet headed Dec 1929: 5 <sup>th</sup> sheet headed Jan '30. Others say 1928-9 & Sept 1930.
<b>28</b> Navy blue hard cover notebook, brown cloth spine.	School note-book possibly with some later use 1930s.	School notebook. Some marked school geography work. Rest notes on various subjects, including personal thoughts and outlines for novels.

<b>35</b> Dark blue hard cover notebook with faded blue cloth spine.	???? 1930s	Notes on books. Miscellany of thoughts, notes, ideas.
<b>36</b> Pale green cloth cover notebook.	????? 1930s ?????	Notes, including chronological list of significant dates/events from Treaty of Berwick to 1653. 14 ?chapter headings, of which 11 covered in note-book, including English Revolution, religion, etc.
<b>37</b> Pale green/fawn paper cover notebook.	????? early 1940s ???	Notes on a very wide range of subjects, eg Church & religion, Reading History backwards, Hobbes, Milton, Locke, Niebelungenlied, Restoration comedy & Ireland, King Lear, Dvorak etc.
<b>38</b> Dark blue marbled hard cover notebook with pale blue cloth spine.	???? 1930s, school and student notes.	Began as ? school classics notebook then becomes student notes on & extracts from books. Sheet 1 headed Balliol. Mostly French, including family trees.
<b>39</b> Grey card cover notebook.	??Late 1920s. School book, re-used as student ??.	Early use as French vocabulary book. Notes on books, mostly French, also German with most notes in French or German. Some publication dates 17 <sup>th</sup> century up to 1929. Books on mainly French history.
<b>40</b> Dark blue hard cover notebook with faded blue cloth spine.	Early 1930s. School notebook & ? later use.	Latin prose translations, dated 30.9.30 – 14.3.31. Then notes on books, mostly in English with some French & German. Passages from authors and notes; subjects include Montaigne, Voltaire, Eckermann on Goethe, Hume Essays, St Augustine Confessions, Lessing, La Rochefoucauld, Hobbes Leviathan, Woolf [The] Waves, Gooch History & Historians of 19 <sup>th</sup> Century, Poe, Adam Smith, Descartes.
